Why Street Smart?

Students interact with the road network in many ways every day and therefore it is vital that all students develop an appropriate set of skills and be reminded about the importance of road safety.

RAA, together with our sponsors, Lifetime Support Authority, Think! Road Safety and the Government of South Australia believe that road safety is a fundamental life skill that all children should develop.

Targeted road safety instruction enables students with additional needs to develop appropriate skills and knowledge about safety in the road environment.

The program provides:

- a trained, qualified teacher that co-plans and delivers a 30-minute lesson
- an incursion held at your educational facility
- lesson or lessons that are individually tailored to suit the needs of your school and your students
- information for parents/caregivers to continue road safety learning at home.

The program is available as a community service and is free of charge.



Teaching and learning linked to the Australian Curriculum

Our lessons have been designed in conjunction with the Australian Curriculum.

Street Smart Primary teachers work with the school coordinator to plan lessons that meet the needs of the target audience.

How many lessons can a school have?

The visiting Street Smart teacher will deliver up to five lessons per visit with lessons being 30 minutes in duration. Subsequent visits enable all students to have a small, focussed session.

Does the classroom teacher need to prepare anything for the lesson?

No, the Street Smart Primary teacher will bring all the required resources.

What preparation is required by the school?

Once a booking is made, your school will be contacted, by the Street Smart teacher to arrange a time to discuss the needs of the school and the students and to confirm all details for the scheduled visit.
